



Targeted Call for Research: National Network for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health researchers

for funding commencing in 2020

NHMRC opened the Expression of Interest (EOI) stage of the Targeted Call for Research: National Network for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health researchers (National Network TCR) on 4 December 2019. EOI applications closed on 12 February 2020.

The National Network TCR aims to bring together Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health research groups and their support networks to create an inclusive structure that builds the capacity and capability of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health researchers.

Applications received during the call were peer reviewed by an expert panel. Following peer review, five EOI applications received seed-funding from NHMRC. Details of the awarded grants are provided below:
